

## MANUFACTURERS RECOMMENDED CARE OF CANE ROCKERS

Your rocking chair was handcrafted by hardworking North Carolinians with pride and love. We use red oak and hand woven cane seats and backs to make your rocker comfortable and durable.

Cane is a natural fiber that will last for years with proper care. To keep your seat and back from becoming brittle we recommend a light misting monthly and more especially if your rocker is kept near a heating vent.

Should you find a loose or broken piece, use a small amount of wood glue to repair. Pressure will need to be applied with a heavy object or clamp to help the cane lay flat.
